SURVEILLANCE INCIDENT NEAR AYLESBURY

Dear ICO,

I am complaining about CCTV surveillance by Envision (<u>https://envision-is.co.uk/</u>) acting on behalf of HS2 Ltd. I made a subject access request (under GDPR), and a request for documentation of the rules under which this operation was carried out (under FOI), but have received only read request acknowledgements.

The request was initially made to HS2 on 13-July-20, who referred me to their contractor. (see *FOI-20-3710 response.pdf*). I then complained to Envision – see 200715_Envision_Request...pdf

In Envision Correspondence.pdf you can find

- Read confirmation for my complaint, 16-July
- Reminder, sent by me, 19-Aug
- Read confirmation for the reminder, also 19⁻Aug

Other than that, I have received no response to my requests. Since this is a clear breach of the time limits for Subject Access and FOI requests, I suggest it would be appropriate for you to immediately remind Envision of their responsibilities in this respect, particularly as they are acting on behalf of HS2, a publicly funded body.

I am also concerned that while there is a CCTV warning sign on the gate of an HS2 compound, in which the surveillance team are located, they are clearly and deliberately capturing images of people in a public car park, outside the compound, where there are no such signs. This would be a violation of the 3rd principle of the CCTV code of practice. I intend to pursue this matter once Envision have provided the rules under which this operation was carried out.
