This image illustrates your team in action at 17:37, at Fairford Leys football pitches near Aylesbury (Lat 51:48:40, Long 0:50:20); I can be identified as the person taking this photograph with a phone. I also request any images captured earlier that day, while I was walking the Waddesdon Greenway near your work site at Fleet Marston.
